#### SCOPE OF WORK

Item	Description
	Construction of Tshikota Cemetery ablution
1	<u>Foundation</u>
1.	<ul> <li>Clear a 7m x 7m site to allow a working space</li> <li>Dig a 2m deep x 1m wide pit and remove excavated soil from the site. Cast 100mm concrete slab 10MPA in the pit AND build a one bricklayer wall on four sides of the pit to the underside of the pad foundation.</li> <li>Set out a pad foundation(3760 x 3260 as per drawing)</li> <li>Arrange steel round bar as per drawing</li> <li>The excavated 100mm deep area for pad foundation must be fumigated and SABS damp proof course be laid. Position your steel work as shown on the drawing.</li> <li>Steel shatters must cover the pit before pouring 25mpa concrete for pad foundation slab with both toilet pan holes in position. Allow the maxim days curing of concrete before working on it.</li> </ul>
	<u>Superstructure</u>
2.	<ul> <li>Lay 9inch damp proof course SABS approved to start with the construction of one brick wall until the underside of the wall plate</li> <li>Brick force SABS approved to be put at four course interval</li> <li>Door frames must be of the same height with the window frames and welded security(burglar on window frames) frames</li> <li>Wall must be plastered internal and external by 20mm plaster.</li> <li>Plastered Walls to painted by cream white G377 and trim 1m high from the ground by Windsor green G33 and trim 1m high inside by white 150 x 150 ceramic wall tiles</li> </ul>
3.	Roof
	All roof timbers must be treated. Construct a gable roof as shown in the drawing with the slope of 16

	degrees and 114 x 20 timber as tip because and 70 x 50 timbers as a welling
	degrees and 114 x 38 timber as tie beams and 76 x 50 timbers as purlins covered by IBR roof sheet
	The exposed timbers must be covered by 220 x 20 asbestos fascia board and barge board
4.	Glasses and doors
	Use obscure 3mm thick glasses in all windows Doors must have shooters inside and heavy duty lock All doors must be painted by G377 enamel including door frame and window frame.
5.	<u>Floor finish</u>
	Floor must be finished off by 400 x 400 x 5mm ceramic floor tiles (rough texture and dark colour).
6	STEEL TANK STAND
	<ul> <li>Set out 1,5 x 1,5 water tank stand foot and dig 400 x 400 x 500 holes</li> <li>Position a 250 x 250 stanchion in each hole with M12 threaded bolt and nut ,use 6mm round bar as strips and tightened with 3mm wire.(DON'T USE WELDING)</li> <li>Cast 15MPA concrete in all four holes and adjust 300 x300 x5 base plate</li> <li>Weld 75 x 50 x 3m high Steel H-section on the base plate</li> <li>The top of the tank stand is fished by 75 x 50 leap channel welded to the H- Section, the space between leap channels 150mm.</li> <li>40 x 40 angle iron must be used as stays of tank stand welded on H section 300mm from the ground and 300mm to the underneath of leap channel.</li> <li>All steel work must be painted by base and finished by enamel paint</li> <li>Mount 5000L plastic tank connect with 20mm black class 3 pipe to serve a one metre galvanised stand pipe with 20mm tap</li> </ul>
	ALL COMPLETED WORK AREA MUST BE CLEANED AND DUST FREE ALL RUBBLES MUST BE TRANSPORTED TO THE DUMPING SITE
