- To provide necessary disclosure note of the abovementioned actuarial valuations as per the requirements of the relevant Generally Recognised Accounting Practice Standards.
- To provide the municipality with a template to perform roll-forward procedures.
- Provide assistance to the municipality during the audit of the financial statements pertaining to these liabilities
- Details on assumptions and factors must be provided, included the source of the information.
- Have appropriate knowledge and experience on Generally Recognised Accounting Practice (GRAP)Standards
