- 6. All projects which are submitted to Vhembe District Municipality for implementing, must be monitored, and a copy thereof submitted to the Mayor's office and Portfolio Committee: Finance before it is processed to Vhembe District Municipality.
- 7. The proposed Taxi Rank project at Elim must be investigated and a suitable site identified for this purpose.
- 8. The Organizational Structure is still under review and once it is done, it will be included in the IDP.
