Important Notice to Members**1. PERSAL contract employees**

GEMS is not always notified timeously via the Employer payroll system of the renewal or extension of employee contracts. This can often result in non-payment of contributions which leads to contribution debt and the possible suspension of benefits. Contract employees should always consult their HR practitioners to confirm that their renewed contracts have been implemented on the Employer payroll system.

2. Employer Payroll Member Refund process

GEMS can only use the Employer Payroll System (PERSAL) to implement backdated amendments such as salary adjustments or changes to dependants, etc. up to three months. Any amendment exceeding three months in the past has to be administered outside the Employer Payroll System. This means that if you have a credit balance older than three months, GEMS will refund the amount via your bank account. Member credits which do not exceed three months will be reclaimed through the Employer Payroll System, and will therefore, be refunded to you via your monthly salary payment.

3. Outstanding dependant identity numbers required

Please ensure that we have your dependants' identity numbers on record to enable us to combat fraud. You can confirm this by checking your contribution statement section 'Member Beneficiary Status' in the column 'ID/Passport Number'. If there is no ID number reflecting in the column ID/passport number for one or more of your dependants, please submit this information to GEMS by using the contact details overleaf, so that we may update your dependants' details accordingly.

4. Suspect Fraud?

Belonging to more than one medical scheme at a time is fraud. Please speak up and report fraud by contacting the anonymous GEMS fraud line number on 0800 21 22 02 (free of charge).
