Makhado Local Municipality hereby invites applications from unemployed residents within its area of jurisdiction to participate in Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) projects funded through the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE). The programme aims to provide short-term employment, skills development, and income support while improving environmental conditions and service delivery.

1. PROJECT CATEGORIES

A. CLEANING AND WASTE MANAGEMENT PROJECT

Participants will be required to perform the following duties amongst others:

- Litter picking and street sweeping, Cleaning of public spaces (parks, taxi ranks, CBDs, villages, and open areas), Waste collection support during service delivery operations, Support during municipal clean-up campaigns and awareness programmes, Basic separation of recyclable materials where applicable.

B. GREENING AND GARDENING PROJECT

Participants will be required to perform the following duties amongst others:

- Tree planting and greening of public spaces, Gardening and maintenance of parks, cemeteries, and municipal facilities, Watering, Weeding, mulching, and basic landscaping, Support for Environmental rehabilitation and beautification initiatives

In line with EPWP objectives, preference will be given to:

- Women- 60%, Youth- 55%, Persons living with disabilities- 2%, Child-headed and indigent households (Proof from Tribal Authority required)
