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1. OPENING AND NOTICE OF THE MEETING

The Speaker, Cllr G T Mukwevho-Mtileni ruled that a moment of silence be observed for meditation and prayer for the women and children who were murdered in Palestine.

REMARK:

The Speaker cautioned Council that what she was about to say might destabilize Council. She then said that Council will not proceed when the Municipal Manager is present in Council because according to her, he was suspended. Cllr M J Mpashe asked the Speaker why the Municipal Manager must not attend the Council whereafter the Speaker indicated that she gave the Municipal Manager the letter of suspension and his response was that he did not respond to me. The situation worsened when the Chief Whip added by saying that the intruder (the Municipal Manager) must be ejected physically out of Council meeting. The Chief Whip's remarks were not received well by other Councillors, and they asked who the intruder is. Many Councillors displayed dissatisfaction about the utterance of the Speaker which led to howling by Councillors who were present at the meeting demanding to know the reason for convening Council if the Speaker was not going to proceed with it.

Thereafter there was a stalemate for about one and half hour until Councillors left and started scattering outside Council Chamber, after that everyone else left the Council Chamber at around 15:40.
